



APPLICATION FOR VETERAN'S FEE EXEMPTION

This exemption is in accordance with Section 16102, Business and Professions Code, which allows every Soldier, Sailor or Marine of the United States, who has received an honorable discharge or a release from active duty under honorable conditions from such service, to hawk, peddle, and vend any goods, wares or merchandise owned by him or her (except spirituous, malt, vinous or other intoxicating liquor), without payment of any license, tax, or a fee whatsoever, whether municipal, county or state. This affidavit, together with listed documentation, is to be filed with the County of Kern County Clerk Office in conjunction with the Fictitious Business Name Statement.
